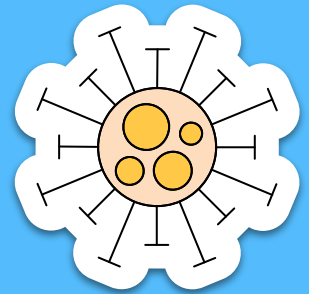
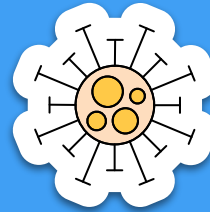


Everything You Need to Know About Our COVID-19 Protocol for Students

SBHS ACCEPTS COVID PCR TESTS ONLY!

Rapid Antigen Tests or At-Home Tests are not acceptable test results for official COVID-19 diagnosis.

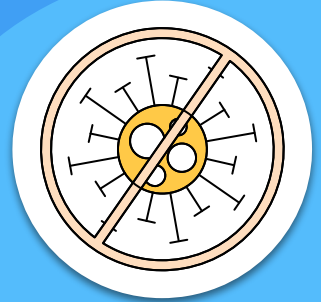


COVID Exposure with No Symptoms

Vaccinated or Un-Vaccinated

Asymptomatic students who have been exposed to COVID are required to:

- Come to school, but must wear an N95 mask.
 - * **NOTE:** If at any time the student is not wearing an N95 mask in school, they will be sent home until they take a PCR test and the results are received.
- Take a COVID PCR test on the 5th day.
 - * **NOTE:** If at any time the student develops any symptoms while waiting for test results, please keep the student at home and notify the nurse.
- Email test results to nurse@sallieb.net
- If the test results are positive, the student must be evaluated by the nurse prior to returning to school.
 - **NOTE:** After quarantine, students should not ride the bus to school until evaluated by a nurse.

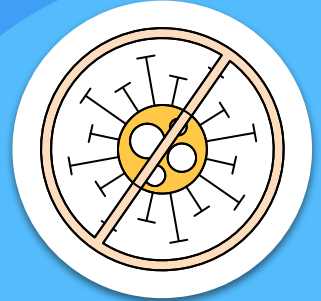


COVID Exposure with Symptoms

Vaccinated or Un-Vaccinated

Students who are COVID-positive or who have been exposed to a COVID-positive individual and are showing symptoms are required to:

- Quarantine for 5 days; Test on the 6th day
- Email test results to nurse@sallieb.net
 - * **NOTE:** Students cannot return to school until test results are received and until they are free of symptoms for 24 hrs without any medication for any symptoms.
 - * **ALSO:** Stay in communication with the nurse about any symptoms your child may be experiencing in order to ensure that the days they are absent are excused.
- Student must be evaluated by the nurse prior to returning to the classroom.
 - **NOTE:** After quarantine, students should not ride the bus to school until evaluated by a nurse.



PLEASE NOTE:

If your child has COVID or has been exposed to a COVID-positive individual and is awaiting test results, **they must wear an N95 mask at school.**

If for some reason that student unable to wear this mask while awaiting their results, they will have to **remain at home until test results are received.**

Additionally, students returning to school after being COVID-positive and fail to wear the N95 mask, **must return home for an additional 5 days.**

IN ORDER FOR A STUDENT'S QUARANTINE DAYS TO BE EXCUSED, THEY MUST HAVE SUBMITTED PCR TEST RESULTS TO NURSE@SALLIEB.NET BY **3PM** PRIOR TO YOUR CHILD'S RETURN TO SCHOOL DATE.
